DIAL-A-RIDE AT YOUR SERVICE

Dial a Ride is a community transport service run by Newmarket Voluntary Network. It offers door to door lifts to residents of Newmarket and the surrounding villages, as well as West Suffolk, for anyone who doesn't have easy access to a car or public transport.

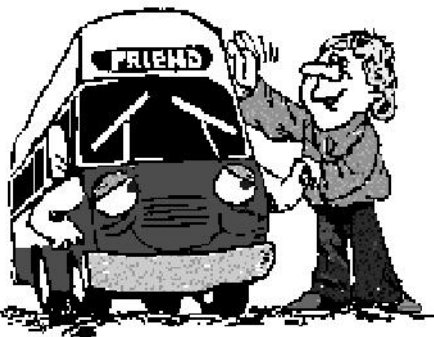
You can use it for all sorts of things – maybe to go shopping, visit friends and family, or go to a day centre. All vehicles are wheelchair accessible and the drivers will help with getting shopping in and out.

At the moment, Dial-a-Ride doesn't have any members in the Chippenham/Snailwell area. However, if there is local demand they'll try their best to help. It's better if more than one person wants to travel from here, as this would make the minibus trips more effective. Passengers are asked to be flexible as to time and day of travel if possible, and it really helps if you can get together.

All passengers pay an annual membership fee, which is £5 in East Cambs. From here, journeys into Newmarket would then cost £6 for a full adult return fare or £3 for concessionary bus pass holders.

Dial-a-Ride needs 48 hours or more notice of your request to travel, so that a schedule can be arranged. They try to accomodate everyone, but being flexible helps - especially at busy times.

Bookings are taken Monday to Friday, between 9am and 12 noon, on **01638 608080**. If you'd like



more information then give them a call. Why not give it a try? Perhaps you have friends or neighbours who'd also like to travel?

Tis the season of weddings, and there are many in our five parishes this year, and next, for many have to book up a venue for the reception, and their favourite place may have been taken already. It happened this year in Chippenham this year, so we have one wedding on a Friday and the next on the Saturday so that the families for both couples can celebrate at the same, superb, country house here.

And weddings are, usually, very joyful, though there may also be minefields to encounter and cross on the way. And the time of preparation also brings joy, of telling others of plans and delving deeper into what the promises and commitment actually mean in every day life.

But what it always comes down to, is two people, looking deeply into each other's eyes and making those solemn vows about the depth of their love for each other (*the implications of which they may only dimly begin to realise*) and the life long adventure into which they have just launched themselves. Almost everything else in the service assumes its own space, for here is the central part, two people, pledging their love for each other, before God. "God is love and those who live in love live in God", writes John. When we align our wills with the divine, in love of each other (*and here it is not confined just to those who make promises in marriage, but whatever our vocation, to be married or single, it is for us all*) then the whole world is transformed. Many of course come to the altar, having known each other for many years, and this seems to be just the formal part of their commitment, though the actual day itself and the enormity of the vows one to the other begins to sink in. Others come in the full flush of youthful excitement, and that brings its own challenges too. Yet others come after bruising and painful previous experiences, and their wariness needs careful nurture.

Here in the five villages, which make up the Three Rivers Group, we had a moving service when the Bishop of Ely and the Archdeacon of Cambridge came to Fordham for Licensing and Installation of Mike as Rector and Kate as Associate Priest. We will both, together with others, minister in all five parishes. And of course, we are available to all in each village for pastoral care, listening, baptisms, funerals and weddings. It is a great privilege to minister here.

Snailwell's magnificent fete brought that whole community together in a special way, so our many and grateful thanks to all who worked so hard to make it such a success.

When we meet others, we are indeed on holy ground, and we can move ever deeper into an awareness of God's presence, of the assurances of Jesus' promises and empowered with His Holy Spirit in our lives.
