Voter ID – Council Elections May 2023

From 4 May 2023, voters in England will need to show photo ID to vote at polling stations in some elections.

This will apply to:

- Local elections
- Police and Crime Commissioner elections
- UK parliamentary by-elections
- Recall petitions

From October 2023 it will also apply to UK General elections.

If you do not have valid photo ID then you are able to apply, free of charge, at www.electoralcommission.org.uk

Postal votes do not require photo ID so are another way to cast your vote. Again, more information is available at the above website.

- 3. Address including postcode
- 4. Any special instructions like:
 - a. Aga additive required
 - b. Oil tank through the gate at left of house
- 5. And of course, how many litres you want and whether you want just that quantity, or a fill up if possible. Please remember that the legal minimum per address is 500 litres (trading standards rules)
- 6. It is your responsibility to ensure that you get a response from me. If you do not, then I did NOT receive your order, and it cannot be included in the Co-op order.

The new year for subs begins on 6 th April 2023. Thanks to the 4 people who have already paid their £5 subs for the period from April 2023 to March 2024. If you want some oil in May, please ensure that you have paid the subs before ordering.



Message from Lucy Frazer MP

It is important that our roads are kept in good condition to ensure the safety of road users, cyclists and pedestrians. Over the past several months, the combination of heavy rain and freezing temperatures has led to several new potholes which I know have caused concern for many of you.


I am pleased that in the Spring Budget the Chancellor announced that the Government will place an extra £200 million towards the Potholes Fund. This takes the total pothole budget for UK local authorities to £700 million in the 2023/24 financial year. The uplift will mean an additional £4.1 million for Cambridgeshire and Peterborough.

Although it is the responsibility of Cambridgeshire County Council to repair the highways in my constituency, I have always been happy to report problems on behalf of my constituents and follow-up with the authority if any issues remain outstanding.

We look forward to seeing people in church, at service times which are at 11am every Sunday, or whenever a quiet moment is needed. The church is there for everyone.
